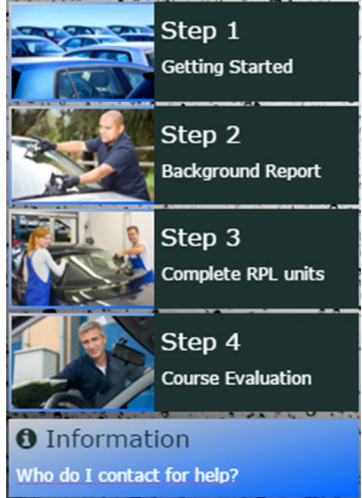
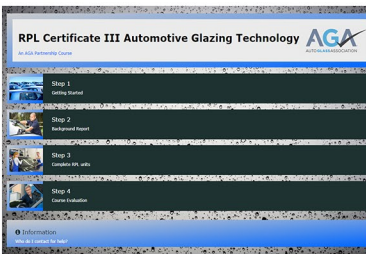
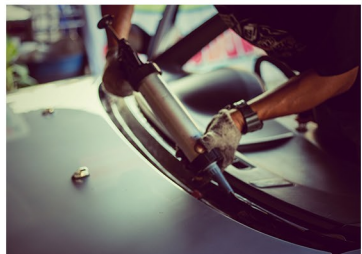
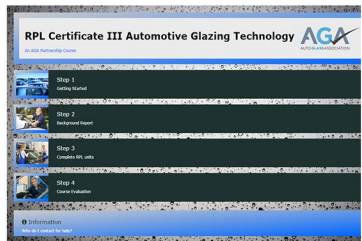


Certificate III in Automotive Glazing Technology - AUSTRALIA'S FIRST 'RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING' PROGRAM IS NOW AVAILABLE



What is it?

The AGA partnered with the Automotive Department at TAFE NSW Riverina Institute, RTO code 90005, to develop a Recognition of Prior Learning program for Certificate III in Automotive Glazing Technology (AUR32216).

Who is it for?

Existing auto glass technicians with at least three year's experience in the automotive glazing industry, subject to eligibility.

What's the big deal?

For the first time ever, employers have a Cert III option that recognises on-the-job training. This makes certification quicker and easier than ever before for eligible applicants, while the stringent verification process protects the integrity of the certificate. According to TAFE, this program is an Australian-first.

What does it cost?

For AGA members the cost is **\$1,980** inc. GST per applicant. For non members, it's **\$2,700** inc. GST. So it's cheaper to join the AGA - with an annual membership of \$275 inc. GST - to qualify for the member-only rate.

How long will it take?

Expected time to complete the RPL process will vary depending on the time management and organisational skills of the applicant. On average, it's anticipated it will take at least one week to gather the evidence, at which time you can submit your RPL request.

How does it work?

It's an evidence-based certification program that takes into account your prior knowledge, so you don't have to relearn information and techniques you've been using for years. You will be asked to submit...

- 1** Candidate background report, outlining time and involvement in the glazing industry
- 2** Self-assessment report, confirming proficiency in a series of competencies mapped to the current training package
- 3** Third-party report from the employer/supervisor
- 4** Further evidence such as repair orders confirming the applicant carried out the tasks, photographic or video evidence, etc. OR a competency phone conversation between the assessing teacher and supervisor.

It's a user friendly online program, accessible 24/7 from any device with internet access, including your phone. Throughout the process you can contact your TAFE teacher via email or phone for support.
