

**Important information for NSW Members**

**Motor Dealers and Repairers Amendment (Tradesperson's Certificates)  
Regulation 2020**

To All Our NSW Members

Today **Member For Tamworth** and **NSW Minister for Better Regulation and Innovation Kevin Anderson, MP** announced on Tamworth Local Radio Station 88.9FM that the Auto Glass and Electrical Accessories industries will be given an exception to obtain the required CERT II qualification until November 2021.

In reference to the amendments announced on the 19 June 2020 to the **Motor Dealers and Repairers Amendment (Tradesperson's Certificates) Regulation 2020** Mr Anderson said " *the Auto Glass and Electrical Accessories component of the Automotive Industry are not ready to change so they've been given an exemption on having that Cert II qualification, their exemption now goes to November 2021. So, it's business as usual for Auto Glass and Electrical Accessories trades they won't need to change anything they will be able to continue as normal*"

This was today also confirmed by the NSW Department of Fair Trading who will provide us with further information shortly as to what this means and how the transition period will be implemented.

The AGA will continue to work closely with the relevant parties with an aim to provide our members ongoing information, resources, and support.

The AGA would like to thank member Shane Broekman from Protector Auto Glass Tamworth whom was instrumental in raising awareness of this issue with his local radio station 88.9FM who were able to engage in direct discussions with Mr Anderson, as the local Member For Tamworth.
