WHY was it formed?

Stakeholders from all sides of the Australian auto glass industry - independent businesses, franchisees, suppliers, etc. - banded together to form a singular, truly independent and non-profit association in the AGA. We don't push the corporate agenda of a few - we represent the interests of the industry as a whole. We act as a conduit of reliable information between suppliers, government departments, the auto industry, associated groups and auto glass technicians across the country.

WHAT does it do?

Lifting the standards is both an aim and a value that underpins every AGA initiative. To that end, the AGA has already: announced an RPL for Certificate III in Automotive Glazing, launched a training portal for auto glass technicians (with industry-specific and general compliance training courses); spearheaded an Australian Standards review; established an online directory of members; hosted industry events and provided business support and marketing assistance to our members.

WHO is it for?

Any Australian business working within the auto glass industry is invited to become a member of the AGA, whether they're private operators or part of a larger group. Our membership also covers insurance companies and suppliers to the industry. If your business is involved in any way with the repair and or replacement of auto glass in Australia, it is eligible for membership.
